What is a Pecha Kucha?

A Pecha Kucha is a short and simple presentation format where anyone has the opportunity to talk about his work or project for 6 minutes and 40 seconds.

No more, no less.

What's the format?

Usually, a Pecha Kucha is made of 20 images, each shown for 20 seconds (20x20'=6"40'), that forward automatically while the speaker talks along to the slides.

So just prepare and send us your 20 slides. But you can also use video or sound, as long as you stay in the time format.

Why?

Because artists talk too much!

This format makes presentations concise, and keeps things moving at a rapid pace

Plus, it is open to anyone.

When?

Zimmerhof 2012 Pecha Kucha will start on Friday 8th at 5pm, and should last as long as the audience...

There will be a first session (from 5 to 7pm) dedicated to the this year's theme. If you are interested in talking about the public (focusing for example on performance or installation work) and the private, please tell us, and we will put you in that first session.

How to participate?

Pecha Kucha works on a first come / first serve basis (which means that your slot may be at 1AM on Saturday...)

To register, you simply need to send

- your details (name, country, profession) - and
- your 6'40" presentation to pechakucha@lagarantie.org before the **15th May**

(please give the following name to your file:

YOURNAME_Titleofpresentation.ppt)

You will receive confirmation of your participation, as well as a guesstimate of your time of presentation before the 30th May.

Rules of engagement

- If several people present different facets of the same project, no more than 3 persons per project will be allowed.
- if you sign up for Pecha Kucha, you will also need to be registered for the Friday session of the Zimmerhof symposium.
